In my current role, I am part of a team responsible for BTCS's crypto staking back-office applications. This involves integrations with external systems (generally via REST) and our internal systems (primarily via Kafka). This code is written in C# / .NET / SQL. Our team also maintain an administration tool developed in Blazor.

In my previous role, I was responsible for the development and maintenance of the search functionality on VIRK.dk, covering data ingestion into Elasticsearch and the design and configuration of Elasticsearch indices.

One of my strengths is my ability to quickly understand code and figure out what it (should) do.

I have often worked with colleagues from different nationalities with diverse backgrounds, ages, and cultures. A key skill in a setting like this is always to make sure we work toward a shared goal.
